RECRUITMENT

Mid-Level Language Apprentice #2021-20 (STROUD) Language apprentices will begin as novice-low speakers and the curriculum used will reflect so. The Proficiency Guidelines, which has been used to develop Sauk language curriculum in previous years, will be the standard in which curriculum will serve as the tracker for apprentices' progression in the language. The purpose of this position is to learn Sauk language for teacher certification purposes. Learn the language through immersion (no English) technique. Language activity development and implementation within Sac and Fox Nation under the direction of the Language Education Coordinator. Must provide Instruction for language activities, classes, and programs for hands on learning. Must be able to work to increase awareness about the status of the Sauk language, participation among tribal members in Sauk language projects. Will perform other tasks related to instruction, language resource creation, and overall program development as assigned by the Sauk Language Education Coordinator or Department Director. Must possess good communication skills and willingness to promote the Sauk language to diverse constituencies. Ability to be an effective member of a diverse team of staff, volunteers, consultants, and interns working with the Sauk Language Department. Must be able to work a full time schedule Monday through Friday. High school diploma or GED required. Bachelor's degree in education preferred. Some college with work experience preferably in tribal field required. Years in college plus years of experience equal to four years or more is acceptable.
