Helps patients navigate often complex health care needs and other needs as defined by the Community Health Manager and other healthcare providers both at the Black Hawk Health Center and outside providers involved in the patient's care. Communicating all the information patients need to make informed decisions about their healthcare. Provide any necessary home and/or community based services as directed by the Community Health Manager. Provide clinically indicated transportation services if necessary. Knowledge and experience providing nursing services in a community and/or home setting. Passion for the proper care and well-being of patients. High school graduate or GED required. Must possess a current, unrestricted LPN certificate and maintain such. Familiar with methods of documentation (PCC's, RPMS, EHR). Experience providing services within ones scope of practice in home, community/office-based setting(s).
