Introduction to the Workbook

The Sauk language comes from the Algonquian language family. Other languages in this family are the Cree, Ojibwa, Shawnee, Delaware, Blackfoot, and Cheyenne. The two closest relatives of Sauk are the Mesquakie and Kickapoo languages. This workbook is an intro to the Sauk language. It is intended to help speakers learn the sounds of the Sauk language and gain basic vocabulary skills. The Workbook Chapters include an Introduction with Pronunciation Guide, Colors, Numbers, Animals, Food, and Greetings. Each of the Chapters has the following sections: Introduction, Vocabulary List, Exercises, Reviews, Applications, and Practice. Learners are encouraged to work through this workbook as a beginning to their journey to learning the Sauk language. Please note that a word or phrase in Sauk does not have the same meaning as in English but they represent similar ideas. The workbook is comprised of various materials provided by the Sauk language department. Use of this Sauk Language Workbook: In the beginning of each chapter the vocabulary words or phrases will be introduced to you, then you can work through the practice exercises. There are 16 chapters go through 1 each week, repeat any section if you have trouble with it. The answers to the Exercises are in the Answers section in the back so you can check your work. After you complete the Exercises work through the Review Exercises, their answers are also in the back if you need them. In the Materials there are Flash Cards for you to cut out and use to help you remember the vocabulary words. There are Placemats to help you remember to speak Sauk at meals and Bookmarks to keep with you so you can recall common phrases until it comes natural to you. Also under Practice sections there are suggestion for activities to do with your family or other language learners so you can apply your new language skills. It is important that you practice as much as possible so you will not only remember the vocabulary words but can pronounce them with ease. Stresses on Words in Speaking Sauk

In general the Sauk language has less stresses in the pronunciation of words than English does. When speaking the Sauk language most vowels are pronounced normally regardless of stress. A vowel becomes reduced to an unstressed vowel or dropped when the unstressed vowel is short A, and that only happens when it is the first or last letter in a word. If you drop or unstressed other vowels as you might do in English, you could sound like you are saying a completely different word. Be careful of your pronunciation! Take time to say it right and practice it. Although stress is less pronounced than it is in English, it is still present. Generally speaking, the stress is on the 3rd from last syllable of a Sauk word."

Objectives for Week 1:

- 1. In this first week you will work on Pronunciation of the Vowel and Consonant sounds that are used in the Sauk language. Use the Chart/Cards and repeat the sounds several times until they come to you easily.
- 2. Below is the Color Vocabulary Read them and try to pronounce them you will be working on this week, remember to use the Pronunciation Guide to help you say them.
- 3. Work though the exercises to see if you remember the new vocabulary words.
- 4. Use the Color Cards and listen to Language CDs to help you remember the new vocabulary words.
- 5. When you say your Sauk Color words do other learners understand which one you are saying? If not keep practicing.


